

Your SSI Advanced Adventurer course is your introduction to diving adventures!

Advanced Adventurer qualifies you to dive to deeper depths anywhere in the world! The course is designed with excitement in mind - whether you are new to diving or have logged 100s of dives.

Most people assume that an Advanced Course is for 'advanced' divers and that they need vast amounts of dive experience to take part. In essence this course is aimed at the not just the experienced diver but also at the new diver.

- This course will refine your skills and build on your knowledge of the underwater world.

If you want to increase your confidence, explore more of the underwater world and develop more of your scuba diving capabilities then this is the course for you!

This course is designed to maximise your in-water learning (there's no classroom or exams), and it's a great way to get more dives under your belt while continuing to learn & develop under the supervision of one of our experienced instructors, so that by the time you have finished the course you will be a better and safer diver.

You will be introduced to a range of different diving types under varying conditions so it's a great way to get a taste of the various Specialty courses that you can undertake to continue your diving education.

Advanced Course Special

Course overview:

This course involves 5 FUN dives with a knowledge review to be completed before each dive, plus a pool skills review session.

Deep Dive - this dive will be up to a depth of 30m (for Junior Open Water Divers 21m)!

Navigation Dive - you will learn natural and compass navigation skills

Advanced Buoyancy -this dive will improve your buoyancy skills so that you have more control and also better air consumption.

Wreck - this dive is at the "HMNZS Canterbury" wreck and it will give you a taste into a popular and adventurous area of diving.

Boat - on this dive you will learn more about the safety parameters around diving away from shore.

Equipment required

- Mask
- Snorkel
- Fins
- Wetsuit (min 5mm) or drysuit
- Boots
- Gloves
- Hood
- Regulator
- Alternate Air source (octi)
- Dive Computer
- BCD
- Weight system
- Dive Knife
- Underwater Torch

Hireage can be arranged, special rates apply up to 50% off - Hireage for all equipment except knife, torch & gloves is \$100

Prerequisites:

- ▶ SSI Open Water Diver or equivalent
- ▶ Minimum 12 years of age
- ▶ Current Dive Medical (conducted within the previous 12 months)
